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**Town of Spafford Local Law # 2-1985**

Regulating parking of vehicles or machinery on  
Town highways from November 1<sup>st</sup> to April 15<sup>th</sup>

It shall be unlawful for any person to park or abandon any vehicle or machinery on the Town or County highways within, the Town of Spafford.

The Town Highway Superintendent is hereby authorized and directed to remove, at his discretion, any vehicles parked on Town or County highways in the Town of Spafford in violation of this local law and to make arrangements for the towing and storage of such, vehicles as he may, in his discretion, determine, with the charges and expenses being borne solely by the owner or owners of such vehicles.

The owner of a vehicle so parked or abandoned on the Town or County highways of the Town of Spafford during the time periods set forth in this Local Law will be in violation of the Local Law and the owner of said vehicle will be subject to a fine of not more than \$50.00 for the first offense, not more than \$75.00 for the second offense within an 18-month period.

**TOWN OF SPAFFORD  
2006 - 2007 SEASONAL ROADS**

The following roads are considered "Seasonal Roads" within the Town of Spafford. They are not PLOWED, SANDED, or MAINTAINED from November 15 to April 15:

- Bacon Hill Road - from the end of the pavement near Route 41 to the intersection of Holzworth Road
- Bromley Road – from Town line to the dead end
- Covey Road - entire length of road
- Morris Run road - entire length
- Ten Mile Point - entire length
- Ripley Hill Road - from Cold Brook Road to the first house on the south end

Dave Hull Road has been removed from our seasonal road list due to construction taking place on that road.

Please keep the above information in mind as you are traveling the roads in Spafford this winter season. Allow yourself plenty of time to reach your destination and remember to drive safely.

## **Building Dept. News**

Some applications for building permits must be sent to the Zoning Board of Appeals, (Special Use, Variances, etc.), which meets monthly. The appeal application must be submitted prior to the 20<sup>th</sup> of the month. Your appeal will be on the agenda for the following month. (If received by January 20<sup>th</sup>, your appeal will be heard at the February session.) You are responsible for informing your immediate neighbors of your plans for your property and that they may attend the meeting. Proof of this notification must be provided. There is a \$15.00 filing fee for each appeal. The cost of your permit is in addition to these fees. ***Approval of your appeal is not permission to proceed with the project; you must receive a building permit/special use permit from the Building Department before beginning the project.***

### **Reminders are a Good Thing! -- Sub Division Information**

With some large parcels in town being offered for sale, each owner and buyer of those parcels need to be aware of is our Sub Division/Planning "rule of thumb". Following sub division of a parcel of land, four residences may be constructed on the original parcel of land; that number includes existing residences prior to sub division. Check with the Building Department to determine if the land has been previously divided; and if any residences have been built. If more than four houses will be on the original parcel, application must be made to the Sub Division/Planning Board. Even if the houses are built at different times, the foregoing applies.

## **Spafford Transfer Station**

The Town Board voted to extend 8 a.m. opening at the Transfer Station through the end of December; and resume the 8 a.m. opening in mid-March. It will continue to be open on Saturdays only. To summarize, the Transfer Station hours are as follows:

Mid March through December 8 a.m. – 4 p.m.

All other 9a.m. – 4 p.m.

Our static clings decals don't like to retain the name and expiration month we write on them. I apologize for the confusion this fading may have caused. For the 2008 the permits will have the months preprinted and we will punch out the month of expiration for your permit. If you do not have a permit, you need to purchase one before you can use the Transfer Station. It cannot be renewed at the Transfer Station. For your convenience, the Town Clerk's office is open Saturday mornings. If your permit is overdue, you will be charged for each year of use from the time of expiration. The fee is \$15.00 per year.
