

TOWN OF SPAFFORD
LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF THE YEAR 1985
ADOPTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF
SPAFFORD ON NOVEMBER 4, 1999

A local law regulating parking of vehicles and/or machinery on Town highways from November 15 to April 15 of each year.

The Town Board, Town of Spafford, County of Onondaga, State of New York, pursuant to provisions of the Vehicle and Traffic Laws of the State of New York, does hereby enact the following Local Law to regulate parking of vehicles and machinery on all County and Town highways within the Town of Spafford, from November 15 to April 15, called the "Winter Season", for removal of snow and ice from such highways.

It shall be unlawful for any person to park or abandon any vehicle or machinery on the Town or County highways within the Town of Spafford.

The Town Highway Superintendent is hereby authorized and directed to remove, at his discretion, any vehicles parked on Town or County highways in the Town of Spafford in violation of this Local Law and to make arrangements for the towing and storage of such vehicles as he may, in his discretion, determine, with the charges and expenses being borne solely by the owner or owners of such vehicles.

The owner of a vehicle so parked or abandoned on the Town or County highways of the Town of Spafford during the time periods set forth in this Local Law will be in violation of the Local Law and the owner of said vehicle will be subject to a fine of not more than \$50.00 for the first offense, not more than \$75.00 for the second offense within an 18-month period.
