

The Town Board of the Town of Spafford assembled at the Spafford Town Hall, 1984 Route 174, Skaneateles, New York with Supervisor Webb A. Stevens presiding and the following Board members present: Councilor Rick Fesko, Councilor Ken Lieberman, Councilor Merrill Clark and Councilor Jeff Ireland. Town Clerk Lisa Valletta was also present. Supervisor Stevens called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

BICENTENNIAL COMMITTEE

The preliminary plans for the community picnic on August 27, 2011 to celebrate the bicentennial of the Town of Spafford were discussed. \$5,000 has been included in the 2011 Town budget to cover some of the costs for the celebration.

PROPOSED LOCAL LAW 2010-3

The Town Attorney is preparing a draft of the proposed local law for licensing dogs in the Town of Spafford. Copies for the Town Board are expected next week.

COMPLAINTS

- Mr. Frank Marcheterre -- trees on Town of Spafford property that are too close to a structure on his Route 41 property. Code Enforcement Officer Kim Fairchild has determined the trees do not violate Town of Spafford codes. Supervisor Stevens will draft a response letter to Mr. Marcheterre.
- Mr. Joseph Vecchio -- a new complaint on Mr. William Fesko's property at 2292 Bockes Road. Supervisor Stevens contacted Onondaga County Dept of Engineering who stated the structure on the Fesko property is beyond the County's right-of-way. It has not yet been determined if the structure encroaches on the Town of Spafford right-of-way.
- Mr. Andrew Henderson, Kenyon Road, Otisco sent a letter to the Town of Spafford as Lead Agency for the Southern Onondaga Area Water District (SOAWD) stating his property stakes disappeared during construction of the water tower. The guarantee for restorations/repairs under the SOAWD construction contract has expired. The Town Board unanimously determined that Mr. Henderson's claim is not eligible for correction by SOAWD due to the expiration of the guarantee.

SURPLUS EQUIPMENT

A motion declaring the Brother MFC-4800 fax machine as surplus equipment with no value was made by Councilor Lieberman, seconded by Councilor Clark. The motion PASSED. AYES – 5, NAYS – 0.

PLANNING BOARD

Onondaga County now requires approval from the Town of Spafford for minor sub-divisions. The current sub-division regulations (regulations) provide no procedure for this approval. Members of the Planning Board have drafted revisions to the current regulations. With approval of the Town Board, the draft will be sent to the Town Attorney with the intent to create a proposed local law.

ADJOURNMENT

A motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:10 p.m. was made by Councilor Lieberman, seconded by Councilor Fesko . The motion was carried unanimously.
