

The Town Board of the Town of Spafford assembled at the Spafford Town Hall, 1984 Route 174, Skaneateles, New York with Supervisor Webb A. Stevens presiding and the following Board members present: Councilor Rick Fesko, Councilor Ken Lieberman, Councilor Merrill Clark and Councilor Jeff Ireland.

The following Town Officers were present: Town Clerk Lisa Valletta, Highway Superintendent Carl Wiers, and Code Enforcement Officer Kim Fairchild. Supervisor Stevens called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

**HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT ITEMS**

- Mr. Wiers is waiting for a response from Association of Towns of State of New York regarding the necessary steps to set weight limits on the Town roads.
- The 1983 Hudson equipment trailer purchased at the auction last autumn has vacuum brakes; all the Town equipment has air brakes. The cost to convert the 1983 trailer's brakes would be \$4,500. Mr. Wiers recommends placing the 1983 Hudson equipment trailer on the auction list for \$3,000: the amount is paid by the Town to purchase said trailer.
- The 1962 trailer that was sold last autumn has not yet been collected by the purchaser.

A motion to declare the 1983 Hudson 20 ton equipment trailer as surplus equipment was made by Councilor Ireland, seconded by Councilor Fesko. The motion PASSED. AYES – 5, NAYS – 0.

**TRANSFER STATION SIGN**

A motion to purchase a 20-inch by 28-inch sign at a cost of \$60 for the Transfer Station was made by Councilor Fesko, seconded by Councilor Lieberman. The motion PASSED. AYES – 5, NAYS – 0. The sign is to remind people to renew their permits annually and to display them on their vehicles when they use the Transfer Station.

**MISCELLANEOUS**

- The Board discussed the upcoming Memorial Day event at the Veterans' Park. A speaker is needed as well as a veteran to lay the wreath.
- The condition of the building at the Transfer Station is sub-standard; repairs need to be made.

**BARROW'S VIEW PROPOSAL**

Mr. Thomas Valenti, a partner in Cameron Group, LLC has proposed plans for the property formerly known as Mid-Lakes Golf Course. Mr. Valenti's proposal includes a meeting center, a bistro, a nine-hole golf course and 65 homes. The Town's Zoning Ordinance dictates this proposal would need to be submitted as a Planned Development District. The Board noted various areas of concern in the proposal. The Town Clerk is instructed to send a letter to Mr. Valenti inviting him to attend a work session with the Town Board on Thursday, March 25 at 7 p.m. at the Spafford Town Hall to discuss the proposal.

**ADJOURNMENT**

A motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:05 p.m. was made by Councilor Clark, seconded by Councilor Ireland. The motion was carried unanimously.
